NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS

At long last we are pleased to advise/announce that our parish consisting of the villages of South Cadbury and Sutton Montis both now have the benefit of having a defibrillator available.

Please note that in South Cadbury it is sited in the centre of the village on the side of the Miles family workshop at the top of Compton Road and in Sutton Montis it is sited within the red telephone box on the front of Sutton Montis Village Hall.

Unfortunately, due to current Government Covid restrictions the Ambulance Service are not able to offer their normal “hands on training” for residents, but they are hopeful it will not be too long before they can offer/re-start their training, in the meantime, the defibrillators come with full instructions, there is a notice sited above it and there is also plenty of information available on the internet which highlights the general principles for the use of defibrillators if you wish to look it up for yourselves.
