Open Session - no items were raised during the open session other than objections to a planning application listed for discussion on the agenda

PC 2025/76 Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs David Soper and Peter Cook

PC 2025/77 No Interests were declared in any agenda items

PC 2025/78 The following Planning Applications were considered

1. 25/01640/HOU Ireson House Sutton Montis Yeovil Somerset BA22 7HF A two-storey extension to the rear of Ireson House to form an annexe with a link connecting the existing single storey garage on the north east to the new extension, to provide an open plan kitchen/living space with two bedrooms

As invited by residents of a neighbouring property, councillors inspected the area of the proposed development from their dwelling to assess the impact. The following concerns and observations were raised by the public

- The extension is out of proportion
- Flooding concerns from hill runoff
- Soil compressed from wheeled vehicles will prevent take up of moisture
- Existing soak-aways are inadequate
- Increase in impermeable surface will reduce the drainage area
- Part of property is subterranean
- The proposed extension is on a higher level than the main house
- Water collects in the well of the property at entrance to the kitchen It was unanimously agreed to **object** to the application

2. 25/01937/FUL Teals 1 Orchard Lane South Cadbury Yeovil Somerset BA22 7FS

Carry out alterations to include extensions to farm shop to provide improved facilities, including additional retail and take-away food areas, alterations to access and enlargement of parking area

It was unanimously approved to support the application and comment on
concerns about safety access for cyclists and pedestrians approaching via the
slip road from Chapel Cross
